



KIDS MINISTRY CHECK-IN POLICY

Your children's safety is our utmost concern at CCC. We provide a secured wing during our Sunday morning services and have doorkeepers stationed at the entrances of the wing to assist you with our computer check-in system, finding classrooms, and assuring that only those with a valid badge enter the wing.

When Can a Child be Dropped Off:

A child may enter the wing and be dropped off at their class 15 minutes before service begins and no later than 20 minutes after service has started. This helps us ensure that classrooms receive minimal interruptions as they teach your children. Once the doors are shut and locked, no more latecomers will be permitted in. However, you can find some children's activity bags just outside the sanctuary to use when your child joins you in the main worship service.

When Can a Child be Picked Up:

We encourage parents not to pick up their child from a class until the adult service has been dismissed. We realize there may be times when a parent needs to pick up their child before that time; therefore we do have a doorkeeper at our main entrance to assist you. The necessary badges will be required for a parent, grandparent or guardian to pick up his or her child, and to have access to the wing.

Who is Allowed In:

Only children who have been checked in, adults who have a pick up tag, staff or visitors who are accompanied by a staff member may enter the secured wing and/or classroom.

Visitors:

If it's your first time visiting Community Kids, please be sure to tell us so we can give you an extra warm welcome! If you wish to visit our wing during Sunday morning services, any of our available Community Kid's team staff would be happy to give you a tour. You are also welcome to look at the facility any time the church is open outside of Sunday mornings.

Occasional Circumstances:

Visitors will be permitted to enter the children's wing beyond the 20 minute guideline. If your child regularly attends CCC and is consistently on time, but a situation that has occurred beyond your control (such as car trouble), please let the doorkeeper know. We extend grace in these situations, and will allow your child to enter the classroom.
